Rationale:

Assessment and reporting are integral to improving student learning outcomes. Teachers plan for assessment when developing teaching and learning activities. Reporting is communicating the knowledge gathered from assessing student learning. It occurs between teachers, students, and parents and caregivers in many formats.

Reporting Processes:

The following is an outline of what is expected for this year.

Term 1 Acquaintance Night

- Tuesday Night, Week 2.
- Various Formats

Parent Teacher Interviews

- Weeks 8, 9 & 10
- Expectation that all parents are invited to attend.
- Format can be Parent/Teacher interview or Three Way Conferences.

Term 2 Written Report

- Includes information on each Area of Study.
- Sent home Thursday Week 10

Term 3 Parent/Teacher Interviews

- Optional and as a follow up to the written report.
- Early in the term
- Format can be Parent/Teacher interview or Three Way Conferences.

Term 4 Written Report

- Includes information on each Area of Study.
- Sent home Thursday Week 9.
