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From the Acting Principal.....

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

The South Australian State Government has made a commitment to move Year 7 students into secondary schools across SA by 2022. At this stage there is no need to make any

changes to the transition or enrolment process of Year 7 students to public secondary schools, however, some private schools have decided to begin the Year 7 transition in 2020.

If you have a child or know of anyone who has a child who is starting school in 2019 please ensure that they have completed an enrolment form and bring it into our Front Office as soon as possible. It is important that we have enrolment forms to ensure that all information is provided to families to ensure a smooth start to school. These forms also assist us with 2019 planning and staffing.

We will be offering a parent information session for the Parents/Caregivers of all students starting school in Reception in 2019. This will be followed by a six-week transition program where the students will attend school on either a Wednesday or Thursday starting in Term 4 Week 2. If you know of other families who may be moving into the area and wishing to enrol in our school, please encourage them to book a time to speak with me and have a tour of our school and/or complete an enrolment form. In addition to this, if you know that you will not be returning to our school next year could you please inform Jayne via the Front Office so that we can take this into our planning considerations as well.
