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## From the Acting Principal.....

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Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Our new reception students have completed their transition visits this week and we are looking forward to them starting school with us at the beginning of next year. If you are aware of any students who are starting school in 2019 who have not yet enrolled at our school or if you are not attending Thiele Primary School in 2019 please contact us as soon as possible so that we can finalise our class placement process.

If you have preschool age children or know of families with preschool age children the following information regarding enrolling at the Campus Preschool maybe of interest to you.

The Department for Education have been working through the school capacity issues and how to best meet the needs of the changing demographic in the South Valley. Enrolment caps are calculated on historical and

projection data using a set formula. These enrolment caps can and do change over time to better meet the needs of local communities and ensure appropriate access for local families exists wherever it is needed. This has occurred at the Campus Preschool and the enrolment cap for 2019 and beyond is reducing from its current number of 77 to 66 children. Enrolment priority is given to the children who live in the local catchment area. For those families living outside the catchment area wishing to apply for a place at the Campus Preschool, you will need to identify at least two other preschools options on your enrolment form, as per the instructions on the Campus School website.

Sec 106A of the Education Act 1972 enables schools, in consultation with the school council/community to continue to set, collect and recover a Materials and Services charge.

At the Governing Council Meeting held on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> November, it was moved to increase the 2019 Materials & Services Fees to \$310.00. Thiele Primary School has received endorsement from the Department for Education and Child Development for this decision.

The Governing Council will meet on Tuesday December 4<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 7.00 pm in the Thiele staffroom to ratify the Materials & Services Fees for 2019 and if you wish to make comment on, or enquiries about the proposed increase, you are invited to attend this meeting.

A copy of the water-marked proposed Materials and Services charges notice for 2019 is enclosed for your information.

You may either attend the meeting or write to the Governing Council Chairperson, Mrs Juliet Craker to express your opinion of the proposal to legally enforce the Materials & Services fee outlined. 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## Armistice Day

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To celebrate 100 years since the end of World War 1, Campus students were involved in the Remembrance Day Ceremony on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> November at 11am. The students recognised the 93 men and wome from the Aberfoyle Park area who served in World War 1 by acknowledging them on individual pavers in the Memorial Garden and participating in the poppy drop. The poppy drop involved schools within South Australia colouring in and cutting out a poppy which was sent to be dropped out of a veteran aircraft at the Remembrance Day Service at War Memorial Drive in Adelaide. As the poppies were dropped they scattered around the city and countryside to be found and remembered by people in the local area. One of the poppies coloured in by a young student from Campus was found and an article was published in the local paper. We knew it was one of our poppies because it had the name of one of our 93 service men and women written on the back of it.
