# 2023 Campus Sports Day

## Friday 10 March 2023

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Our annual Sports Day will be held on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023 (week 6, term 1) on our Campus ovals, gym and COLA. Sports Day has an emphasis on participation by all. Every student will receive at least one point for their team for each event that they participate in. Students who are unable to compete due to injury (or other reasons) will be encouraged to support and help with one of the many jobs needing to be done on the day.

### GENERAL Information

- The day **starts at 8:45 a.m. sharp** on the Middle Oval, with the official Opening followed by a whole Campus Health Hustle. Classes will then head off ready to rotate through events, as a class group with their teacher at 9.20 a.m.
- Please provide water, recess and lunch as usual unless you have pre-ordered lunch.
- **House Teams are Flinders (Red); Murray (Blue); Eyre (Yellow) and Yorke (Green)** - Children should retain their house colour from last year and this should remain with them throughout their time at the Campus.
- All children are expected to **wear a T shirt in their team colour**. Ribbons and badges may be worn, as long as they do not impede participation in events, and coloured zinc cream (as lines only, not whole face smeared!) may also be used
- **Please note: No excessive** hair colouring or excessive face paint! No colouring or face paint items to be brought to the Sports Day.
- **Hats** will be required and sunscreen will also be available from your class teacher. Please also apply sunscreen before the children come to school. As parents, please ensure we model Sunsmart Policy and Slip, Slop, Slap, Wrap.
- The Reception/Foundation to Year 2 events will take place on the Asphalt next to the COLA, the COLA, the Middle Oval and in the Gym. The Years 3 to 6 events will be held on the Top and Middle Ovals.
- Primary children earn points for their House Team and these are tallied across the classes. There is a shield for the Winning House Team and one for Best Team Spirit.
- Immediately after lunch at 1pm the children will assemble in their House Teams for the finals of the track events.
- **Reception/Foundation to Year 2** - Events will finish by approximately 12:35pm. **Students will need to stay with their teacher until normal finish times UNLESS THEY HAVE BEEN SIGNED OUT BY THEIR PARENTS/CAREGIVER.**
- Children are to stay with their class teacher throughout the day and recess and lunch times will be held as per the timetable.
- The Sports Day will **finish at approximately 2.20 p.m.** **Students will need to stay with their teacher until normal finish times UNLESS THEY HAVE BEEN SIGNED OUT BY THEIR PARENTS/CAREGIVER.**

### Help Wanted – You can help by:

- Attending on the day and supporting your child/children.
- Assisting the teacher at events when asked – timer, measurer, scorer, etc.

### Catering

Coffee this year will be supplied by **Let there be Coffee** and will be located on the middle oval. The Campus canteen will also be providing food options for the day, this will be communicated by them closer to the event.

### First Aid

There will be a First Aid station set up under the scoring shelter between the middle and top oval. Each school front office will also have First Aid available.

### Inclement Weather

In case of inclement weather, we will advise parents of a postponement and the Sports Day will be held on Tuesday the 28th March (week 9, term 1).

## Trial Day and Champions Trophy

Trial Day will be held on **Thursday 23rd February** (week 4, term 1) on the Campus middle oval. This day is for students in Year 3 to 6 who wish to trial for Sapsasa athletics (Campus), SACSA athletics (Pilgrim) and SACPSSA athletics (Nativity) teams. Data will be collected and used throughout the year for the various athletics carnivals.

Trial Day is also used to collect data for Year 3 to 6 students wanting to qualify for the 100m and 200m finals on Sports Day.

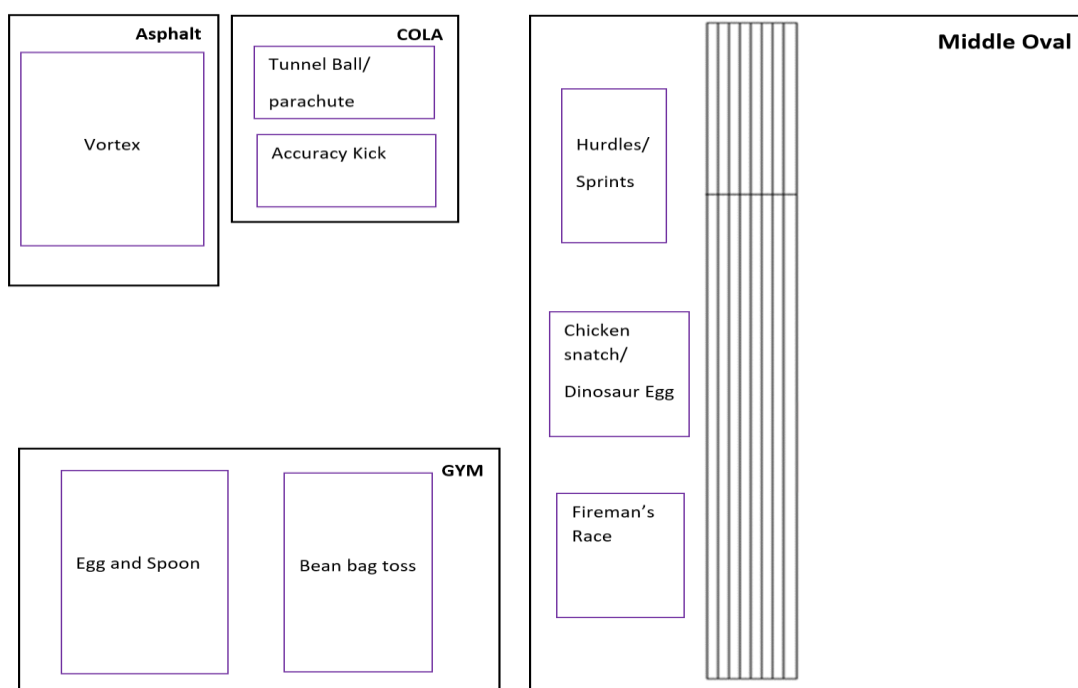

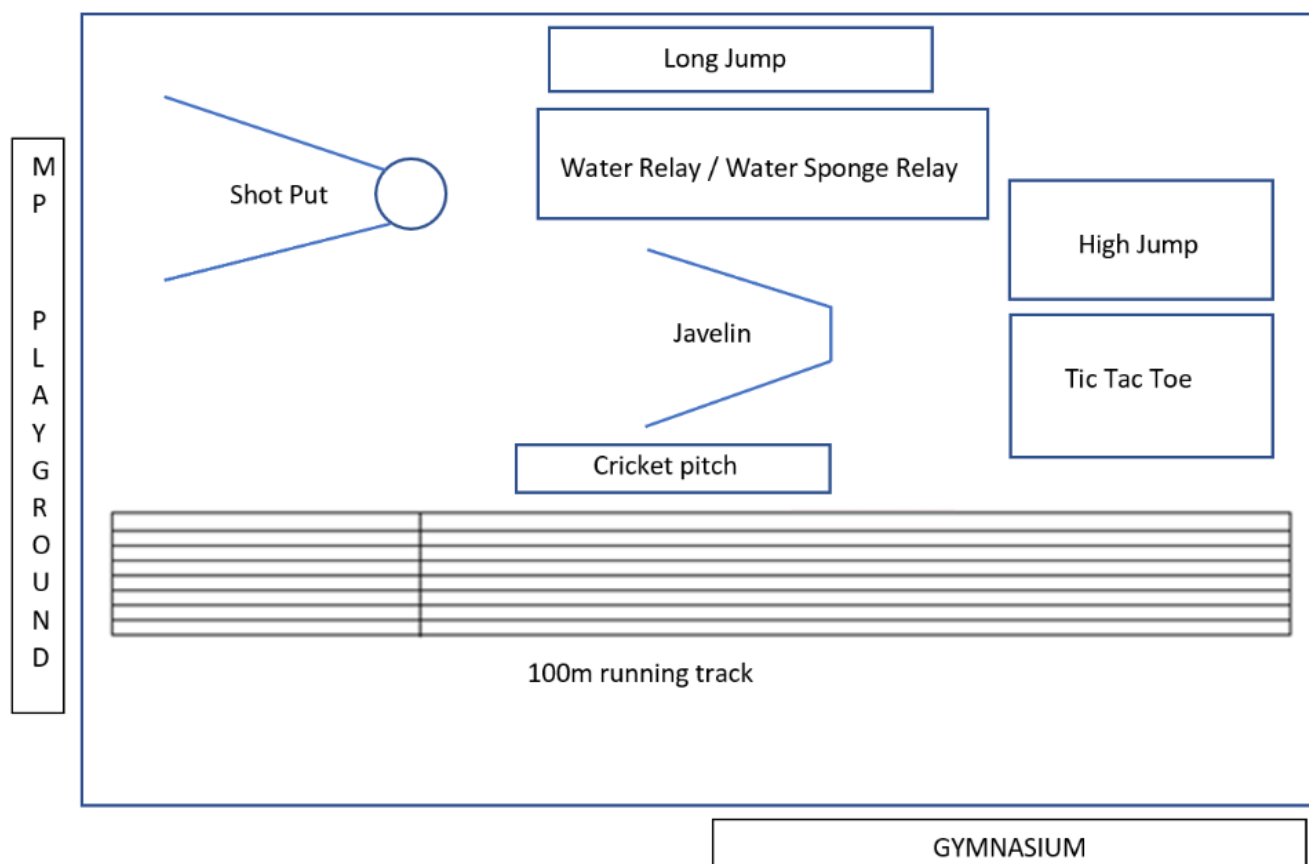
