Dear Parents/Carers,

Last Tuesday, staff and students celebrated Harmony Day by wearing something orange. Harmony Day is the celebration that recognises our diversity and brings together Australians from all different backgrounds. It is about inclusiveness, respect and a sense of belonging for everyone. Classes buddied up together and participated in dances inspired by different cultures with a dance instructor from Footsteps Dance Company.

Before the end of the term speakers from the Northern Area Migration Resource Centre will be visiting our school to speak to students in the Coorong building about Refugees, and this will be followed up with excursions to the Migration Museum by students in T1, T2, T3, T13 and T14. These excursions will occur in the last week of this term for the students in the Heysen building and early in term 3 for the students in the Coorong building.

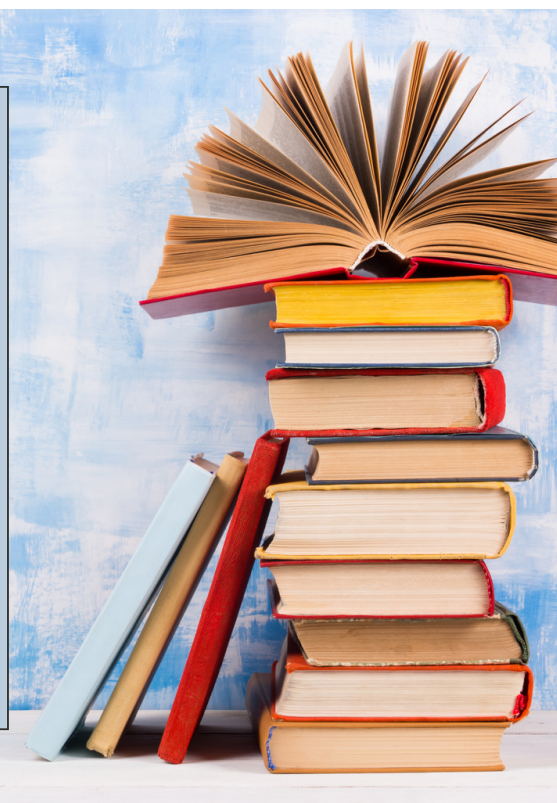
