Dear Parents/Carers,

I am pleased to announce that as part of the federal government's 'Student Wellbeing Boost' we will be receiving additional funding to spend on activities to support our student's mental health and wellbeing at Thiele Primary School. At this stage we are unsure of the amount of money we will be receiving; however, we will keep you updated once we are informed.

Following on from our Bully Survey conducted at the end of Term 1, we have booked SafetyNet information sessions for students and parents/carers on the topic of cyber safety. The SafetyNet Programs key aim is to achieve a reduction in bullying and conflict, increased awareness of this topic, and improvements in overall mental health and wellbeing.

The SafetyNet Program will be presented to our year 3-6 students in the first week of Term 3. This program will explain cyberbullying (what it is, what it is not, how to recognise it), online activities, online dangers, respectful behaviour, gaming and age restrictions in Australia, digital footprint, privacy and where to go for help.

The parent/carer SafetyNet program 'It takes a village' is a 1.5 hour program explaining bullying, statistics, current online/social media trends and dangers, account management, privacy and reporting, what parents can do to help reduce online risk and harm and where to go for help. If you are interested in attending this online program on Thursday 27th July at 7pm – 8:30pm, there will be a link available soon for you to register.

We have had an influx of new potential families touring the school and it has been wonderful meeting with them all and showcasing all our school has to offer. If yourself, or someone you know, have a child who is due to start school at the beginning or mid-year in 2024, please contact Renata in our front office to organise a school tour with myself.

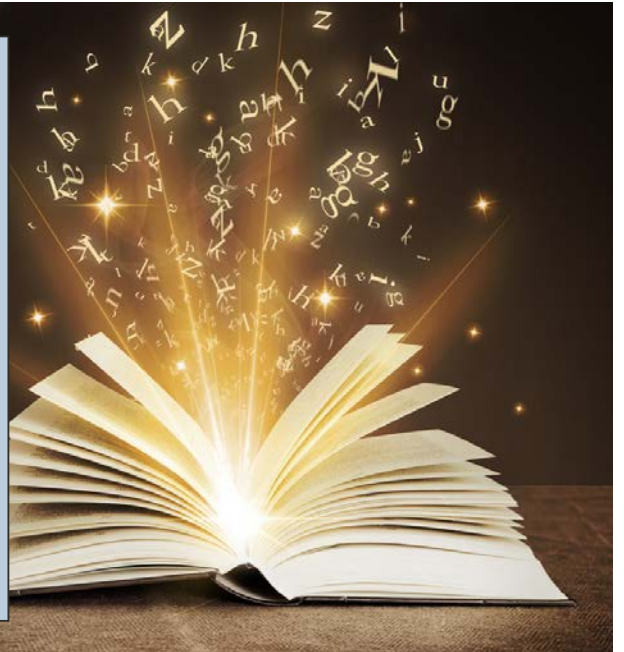
SECOND-HAND UNIFORM SHOP
