From the Principal

Dear Parents/Carers.

Welcome to 2024! I hope that you all enjoyed the school holiday break with family and friends. We are looking forward to starting the new school year and seeing our students and school community again. Since the end of last year there have been some changes to our staff at Thiele. Please see the staff list on the following page.

Our school values are: Respect, Sustainability, Integrity and Achievement and these values underpin all that we do and are reflected in our school assemblies and referred to in conversations with students around behaviour, rules and responsibilities.

Punctuality and attendance is critical to student achievement. The first school bell rings at 8:30am and students are welcome to arrive from then, classes officially starts 8:45am. If the classroom door is not open at 8:30am, it is essential students wait quietly outside until the second bell rings. For safety reasons, playing around the buildings and on the ovals is not permitted at this time.

If a child arrives later than 8:45am, they will need to visit the front office to sign in before going to their class, parents/carers will be notified via sms if their child is not at school. We request that parents/carers notify the school if their child is absent and complete a form for periods of absence longer than 3 days. This year we are continuing our focus on improving reading fluency and comprehension through our commitment to reading. To encourage and support home reading, the school has purchased home reading diaries for all students to record and celebrate their reading achievements at home. After students have completed reading in increments of 25 nights, they will be awarded certificates celebrating their achievements. Students in Years 3-6 will participate in 'Spelling Mastery' lessons. Spelling Mastery lessons are 8:55am - 9:15am Monday through to Thursday. This program follows daily lessons and uses an explicit, teacher-directed method of teaching and requires attendance and engagement in daily lessons.

More information will be provided by class teachers at Acquaintance Night on Tuesday 6th February, where you will have the opportunity to meet your child's classroom teacher and gather information about their class expectations and routines, as well as attend our school Annual General Meeting where you will have the opportunity to meet our staff and be introduced to our class SRC - Student Representative Council representatives, Sports Captains, YELP - Youth Environment Leaders, Choir Captains and Performing Arts Captains students who have been elected this year.

We are looking forward to another successful year for all of the students at Thiele Primary School.
