It was wonderful seeing many of our families at our sports day on Friday. Congratulations to everyone involved in the day, especially to Murray who won the Sports Day Shield and Flinders who won the Spirit Shield. Many thanks to Brett Middleton for organising this event and for making the changes to accommodate the weather conditions as well as to all of the staff, students and volunteers who helped out on the day.

Over the past 4 weeks our Year 6 students have participated in the LifeChanger program. This program is centered on empowering students to develop a better understanding of themselves and take steps towards becoming the person they want to be. Throughout the workshops students explored various concepts including the power of emotions, importance of embracing change and bouncing forward from challenges, understanding values and strengths as well as navigating friendships and building meaningful connections.

Measurements and outcomes from student feedback reflected:-

·76% of our students understood what it means to be resilient

·82% of our students identified supports to help them through change

·70% of our students felt more confident that they can bounce back when challenges arise

·84% of our students understood some things in their control and some things outside of their control

· 82% of our students enjoyed or loved the LifeChanger workshops on resilience and change

This week our Year 3 and Year 5 students will be participating in NAPLAN. This will be administered by classroom teachers by students accessing laptops or using the desktop computers. We encourage all students to participate in this process as the feedback from this assists us in supporting your child further their learning.

You are invited to our Reconciliation Action Plan meeting on Friday March 15 at 8:45am in T8. Simon Wilson our ACEO will be attending this meeting and it would be fantastic to see as many parents as possible attend this meeting to learn about our RAP Actions and to see what we have planned for this year. This will also enable you to provide information and feedback to us.






# VOLUNTEERS Wanted


