Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to the mothers who were able to join us for our Mother's Day breakfast last Thursday morning. I hope you all enjoyed the breakfast prepared by our canteen manager Dave, and all of our wonderful mothers enjoyed their special Sunday with their families.

We are looking forward to welcoming our new mid-year reception students into our school for their first transition visit next Wednesday 22nd May. These students will be joining our current reception students in T5 from 9am – 10am for the next 2 weeks and will return in week 7 when they will stay for a longer visit, having the opportunity to play during recess time before going home.

I enjoyed the first YELP Forum at Glenthorne National Park with our Youth Environment Leaders on Tuesday 7th May. At this forum students participated in activities learning about the aboriginal culture of this land, the wildlife within the park and the importance of planting many small shrubs and trees. Specific planting has taken place to attract and encourage wildlife back to the area. This will not only ensure that these species remain available for us to enjoy, but also repair this land back to its natural state.

Under the One Tree, One Child initiative, Thiele Primary School was fortunate to receive 50 shrubs and trees to plant in an area within our school. These plants will attract local wildlife back onto our school grounds by providing food and habitat to local species, as well as increase the canopy of our local area to help support Green Adelaide. The Youth Environment Leaders will use the skills they learnt on their visit to Glenthorne National Park to work with representatives from our local council, our teachers and students to plant and care for these plants. We are looking forward to planting these plants, caring for these plants, watching these plants grow and enjoying the wildlife that comes to our school.

In addition to the beautiful painting on our water tank outside the Coorong building some new tables and benches have now arrived and have been placed outside of the Coorong building to provide seating for our students. The students have been enjoying these and are looking forward to some additional items to be placed in this area in the near future.

We look forward to celebrating and recognising the efforts from all of our parents who have volunteered within our school at our Volunteer morning tea next Wednesday 22nd May. This will be held in the staff room. If you have any spare time during the day to volunteer some time we are continuing to seek volunteers to assist in the canteen any morning Monday to Friday and in the Play Café on Friday mornings.
