YELP Holiday Project

On Thursday during the school holidays our Youth Environment Leaders (YELP) came into school to work with me on their sustainability project. Brodie, Chelsea, Tahlee, Zoe, Acacia and Ben converted eight wine barrels into wicking garden beds and planted them with native indigenous plants that will add colour and fragrance to our garden. The students designed a new sign for the school community garden and spray painted the lids of the 10c recyclable bins burnt orange to make them easier to identify. The class who collects the most 10c recyclable containers get to care for Palmy the orangutan, and the money collected from these containers helps support our school community garden.
